Through this expansion, 360 Clinic continues to successfully leverage Orange County COVID-19 testing supersites, walk-up kiosks, and mobile sites to quickly identify, secure, and position locations in underserved communities while safely meeting the needs of this pandemic.

“The United States Navy has graciously given us this opportunity to serve both the military and the local community,” said Vince Tien, CEO of 360 Clinic. “As an immigrant who moved to the U.S. from Vietnam at the age of 5, it is an honor to be awarded this contract, and serves as a way for us to give back to the community.”

With locations in Orange County and throughout Southern California, 360 Clinic is laying the infrastructure to expand access to comprehensive care in communities that need it the most,

and currently has over 50 locations. As the OC Health Department's official COVID-19 testing partner, 360 Clinic has been the leader in testing for Orange County throughout the pandemic, partnering with cities on public testing initiatives for essential workers and underserved communities.

These new testing sites in San Diego and Bremerton bolsters 360 Clinic's local testing capacity, enabling more symptomatic and asymptomatic government employees' access to cost-free, contactless testing with results given in 24 hours. The more options that are available for individuals to get tested and receive test results in a timely manner, the quicker medical professionals can mitigate the spread of the virus.

Testing is now being performed at a location within 30 miles of the Naval Base Kitsap Bremerton and within a 10-mile radius of the Naval Air Station North Island (NASNI) and operates Monday through Friday from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm. Residents may register online by visiting www.360clinic.md. Participants will be asked to provide their contact information along with health insurance information (if they have it) before being prompted to select their appointment date and time, with same day availability. After a resident has successfully registered, the patient will receive a confirmation text or email.

"Our goal is to do everything we can to slow the spread of COVID-19, including ease of access to cost-free testing to all community members while providing, empowering, informing, and treating the community," Tien added.
